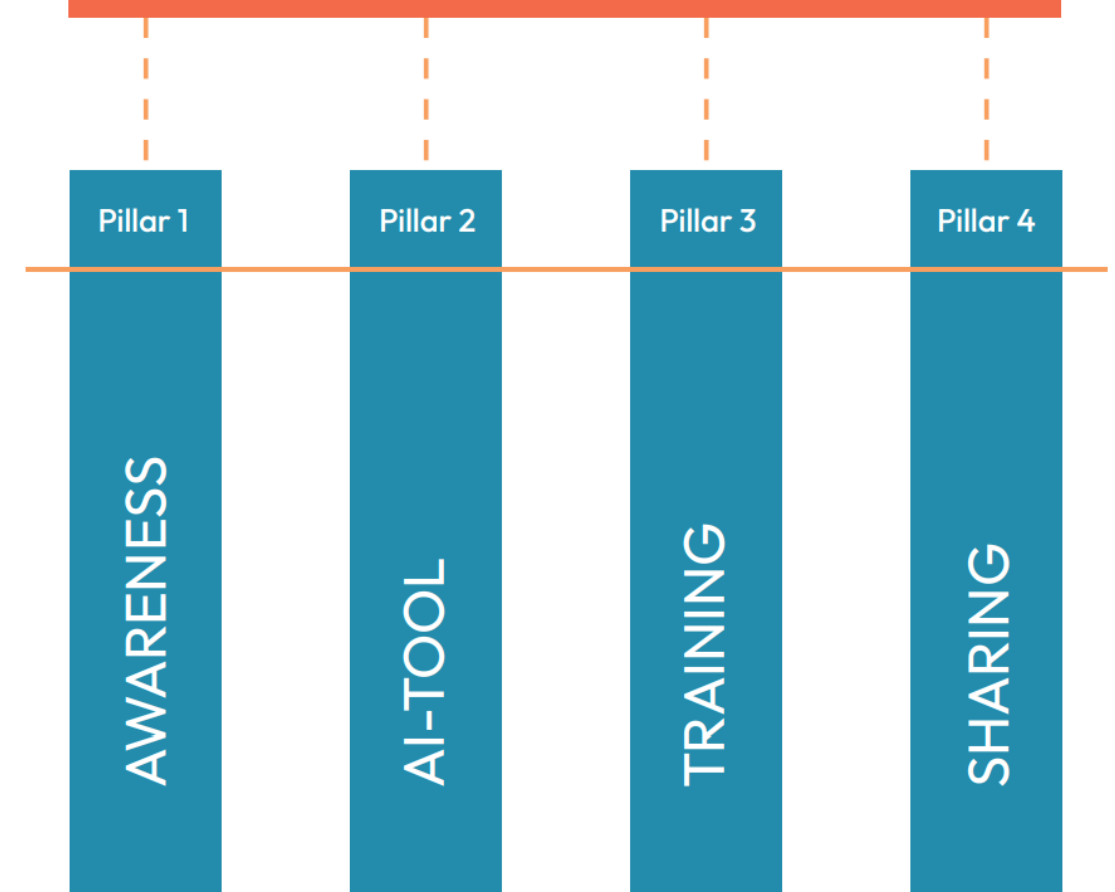
## ABOUT ALLIES

One of the most dangerous misuses in the Internet concerning public security are the usage of social media and websites for dissemination of terrorist content.

On that matter the European Union adopted the “Terrorist Content Online” (TCO) Regulation which requires Hosting Service Providers (HSP) to remove any illegal terrorist content within one hour, after having received an official removal order.

Therefore, the aim of ALLIES is to support micro and small HSPs in complying with the requirements of this TCO Regulation through the creation of the proper learning, training, experience sharing mechanisms as well as technical (AI) tools.

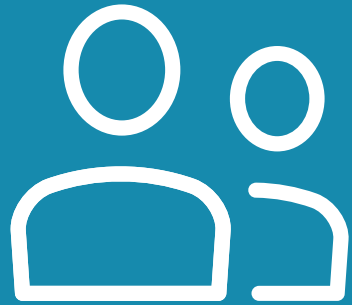
